YAHSAH MESSIAH

THE KEY TO THE KNOWLEDGE OF YAHWAH

Yahsah made a statement to the Devil: "...*it is YHWH God you worship and him alone do you render sacred service.*" **Luke 4:8** By that statement, He let the Devil know YHWH's status and the relationship He has with YHWH His Father.

Later, during his ministry, He spoke that knowledge to the Samaritan woman.

John 4:23,24 Even so, The Messiah being the key to that knowledge made no account to be equal to YHWH. **Philippians 2:6,8**

Yahsah Messiah has given us a clear understanding of what the knowledge of YHWH meant.

John 17:3 Imagine someone giving you a key that opens a door to reveal all the secrets and knowledge of life? How would that make you feel? Would it not make a dramatic change to your life? The truth remains that YH (YaH) has given us that key; that key is Yahsah Messiah.

Ephesians 4:13 Colossians 2:2,3 It is a promise from YHWH that is fulfilled.

MESSIAH PROMISED

We can see how the promise seed is foretold at the time of Cain and Abel when YH made a conclusion concerning His judgments with the serpent; that enmity will be between seeds.

Genesis 3:15; 4:1-8 YH showed no favour to Cain but warned him concerning his badness

Hebrews 11:4. A calculation was made about The promised seed through the reading of the scrolls. **John 1:41; Matthew 16:16**. Daniel the prophet gave his accounts of the promised Messiah. **Daniel 9:24-26**

To find more evidence of the promised seed we need to search the Scriptures in the Psalms and the Prophets. YH Spoke to Abraham about His seed being great and people will bless themselves because of it. **Genesis 22:18; 28:12-15; 49:10; Isaiah 11:1-5**

As we look at the genealogy of the Messiah, we conclude that Messiah came from David's seed. **Matthew 1:1-16; 21:9-11**

Around the 8th century BCE prophet Micah prophesied a Great Ruler was to be born and that this Ruler was to be born in Bethlehem. **Micah 5:2** In the gospel of Luke we see by Providence, Yehoshua was born in the small town of Bethlehem. He was laid in a manger that was situated in a barn. **Luke 2:1-7**

We understand, that at the time when John the Baptist preached repentance, they inquired who he was. They questioned him because they were in expectation of a coming One, who they call The Messiah.

YHWH sent an Angel to declare to the people a Saviour has been born, and other heavenly armies reinforced that message. **Luke 2:10-14** John bore witness of the Messiah by confirmation from heaven. **Matthew 3:16,17** There was others besides John who had witnessed borne to them that Yahsah was the promised One and the son of YHWH.

Matthew 17:1-5 All those putting faith in Him have the witness that he is the Messiah.

THE BEGINNING OF YAHSAH'S EXISTENCE

Yahsah was born by means of YHWH's Holy Spirit. The virgin Mary was chosen to carry Yahsah in her womb. This would mean that Yahsah would not carry the imperfection of man. **Luke 1:34,35; Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:20-23**

Yahsah attended the Passover yearly and at the age of 12 years He was lost to His parents because of his zeal for YHWH. **Luke 2:41-49** Yahsah was empowered by Holy Spirit to perform sign's and wonders, the feeding of the multitudes, healing, expelling of wicked spirits, raising the dead, and even calming the stormy sea. **Matthews 15:35-38 Mark 4:37-39**
John 11:43,44,47,48

Yahsah's love for the people is demonstrated many times in the Holy Scriptures; He healed all types of the sick because He wanted to and His love for His Father reflected that. **Matthews 8:2-4; 15:30; Proverbs 8:31**

Yahsah continued preaching the Good News of the Kingdom of YHWH despite opposition. His commitment to YHWH was second to none. **Matthews 4:17; Mark 14:37,38; Matthews 23:27-33**

YAHSAH FOREVER

Yahsah is ruling as King in the heavens, and we will see His rule upon the earth. After His final commission, all things will be subjected to YHWH. **1 Corinthians 15:22-28** The Scriptures reveal to us the authority of the Messiah in the heavenly realms and also the outcome of all His enemies. **1 Corinthians 15:23-28; Psalms 110:1; Hebrews 10:12,13** Yahsah's return will be with great power; He will carry the wrath of YH with Him to destroy the enemies of YH. **Revelation 19:11-16**

Yahsah is a model for us to follow, that we may be moulded like him, even through suffering. But thanks to YHWH we will be comforted. **1 Peter 2:21-24 2 Corinthians 1:3-5** We will receive the reward of the resurrection to eternal life. **John 5:28,29** No longer would we experience violence nor death, but a new life in paradise. **Isaiah 11:6-9 Revelation 20:6**
