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#### WHO IS THE TRUE GOD

In the big cities there may not be any sense or knowledge of God because of the high buildings, all the desires of humankind and most of what the world offers for the desire of the flesh. Nevertheless, even in the big cities we can still see evidence of God's creation. We can see the sky, the moon and the stars, animals and each other. When thinking about it, all what God has done was purposed. **Genesis** 1:1 **Psalms** 148:1-5 **Psalms** 8:3

The most direct way to describe God is: "The True God is a Spirit". There is no beginning and no ending of God. He is not physical, and He has not manifested Himself as physical. That is why no man has seen God, but that does not mean we cannot search for God and find him. John 4:24; Acts 17:27 Isaiah 55:6 Deuteronomy 4:29 Revelation 4:2-3 John 1:18 Exodus 33:20

#### THE NAME OF THE TRUE GOD

God has many titles but one name. Some of the titles of God are: Almighty God, Most High, Grand Creator and Sovereign Lord, to name just a few.

According to the Holy Scriptures the name of Almighty God is written 6,885 times. His name consists of four letters called the tetragrammaton: Y.H.W.H. These four letters are the consonants of God's name, and when put together with the vowels as pronounces as YaHWaH as if you were pronouncing it, "Ya H WaH" with a throaty 'H.' **Genesis** 17:1 **Psalms** 50:14 **Ecclesiastes** 12:1 **Acts** 4:24 1 **Timothy** 1:17

#### SHOULD THE HOLY NAME OF YHWH BE USED?

It is important to know the name of YHWH, but it is equally important not to use His name in vain. The name YHWH means, "Causes to Become." It goes without saying that when His word goes out it does not come back to Him not having success. What YHWH says or does will always prove to be. **Psalms** 83:18 **James** 4:13-15 **Isaiah** 55:11 **Psalms** 33:9 **Joshua** 23:14

YHWH made his name known to Moses. **Exodus** 3:15 and expressed that his servants only knew him as God Almighty. **Exodus** 6:3. We now have the privilege of knowing the name of YHWH, and more to the point we get to know even the One who holds the name "YHWH."

As for Pharaoh, he did not know the name of YHWH but got to know his name after he experienced devastation by the power of YHWH. **Exodus** 5:1-2 **Exodus** 12:29-31

YHWH has made his name known in the many events that took place historically throughout the Holy Scriptures. In the name of YHWH, the Red Sea was parted, and his people was saved from pharaoh's armies. **Exodus** 14:21-25 **Joshua** 2:9-11

YHWH stated that many nations will come to know his name and that He is the one causing his name to be sanctified and magnified. **Ezekiel** 38:23 The name of YHWH is powerful and life giving. Anyone who calls upon His name will be saved **Romans** 10:13

#### THE QUALITIES OF YHWH

YHWH's qualities are evident in the Holy Scriptures; also, when you build a relationship with YHWH you will experience His qualities. YHWH's quality of justice when dealing with pharaoh, demonstrating his love when fulfilling his promises. **Exodus** 9:16 Who is there that can compare to YHWH's qualities? **Romans** 11:33 **Psalms** 40:5 **Deuteronomy** 32:4; 7:8

We can see the qualities of YHWH in his creation; like the earth that He created and also the Angels and other living spirits. **Job** 1:6; 38:4,7 **Daniel** 7:10 All of God's creations are beautiful and wonderful even to the extent that He made the earth for us to inhabit. **Psalms** 115:15-16 and he has made us to inhabit the earth. **Psalm** 139:14 All that YHWH has done is with the motive of love. **1 John** 4:8

#### YHWH IS MERCIFUL AND GRACIOUS, SLOW TO ANGER, RIGHTEOUS AND IMPARTIAL

The Holy Scriptures explains many things about YHWH; it has answers to some important questions about YHWH. **Exodus** 34:6-7 gives an answer to His grace and mercy but also to remember His righteous anger which He does not hold onto, but rather holds onto the love. **Micah** 7:18-20.

YHWH has a future plan for us, and by His love and mercy He will put all things in order. **Revelation** 21:3-5.

We may find it difficult to cope in a world almost void of God our Father, but He listens to us when we ask for help, so we can make good decisions in order to please him. **Exodus** 33:13 Approaching YHWH with humility has better results when asking favour. **1 Peter** 5:6-7 There is much for us to learn, but YHWH is gracious to humble people. **Luke** 18:13-14 Generally, we are all His creation, and He has love for us more than we can imagine. **Luke** 6:35 **Exodus** 33:19 YHWH extends His love and grace by instructing us in ways that are good. **Psalms** 82:3-4

The mind of YHWH is not like the mind of mankind; He knows the outcome of everything, and He allows His qualities to be manifest to us all. One such quality that YHWH shows is impartiality, **Acts** 10:34-35 which will help us to understand that we must also show impartiality towards one another. **Deuteronomy** 1:17; 10:17

Having communication with God through prayer and applying His word in your life, will help you to start seeing how it will benefit your way of living. **Isaiah** 48:17-18

#### YHWH IS ONE

There is no one that is compared to YHWH, **1 Corinthians** 8:4-6 which is understood by the titles reinforcing this; The Almighty and Sovereign Ruler. By this understanding it is clear to see that YHWH is One. **Deuteronomy** 6:4 **Mark** 12:28-29 In the book of the gospel of John, Yahsah stated that YHWH is greater, John 14:28 and on account of YHWH's greatness Yahsah subjected himself to YHWH. **1 Corinthians** 15:28 Although God has a name and titles He is in fact a Spirit. John 4:24

As you know, with YHWH there is no beginning nor ending but what came into existence from YHWH was His Word. This Word was in the beginning, and it was by this Word that YHWH was manifested throughout the extremity of the world. This Word is Yahsah the Son of YHWH, the first born of all creation. **Revelation** 3:14 **Proverbs** 8:22 **Colossians** 1:15

As you continue in the study of the word of YHWH you will develop a longing for YHWH. Once you know that YHWH loves you it is then that you will form a loving relationship with Him; this will help you to walk modestly with YHWH. **Matthew** 5:3,6; 22:37-38 **Micah** 6:8 Yahsah has great love for His Father which was demonstrated when accepting His Father's Will, by becoming the sacrificial lamb that takes away the sins of the world.
